

## TRAFFORD COUNCIL

### INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT



1. The name of the school is St Michael's Church of England Primary School.
2. The school is a Voluntary Aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of St Michael's Church of England Aided Primary School"
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. Two parent governors
  - b. One LA governor
  - c. One staff governor
  - d. One headteacher
  - e. Seven foundation governors.
5. Total number of governors twelve.
6. Those entitled to appoint foundation governors are:
  - (a) the Diocesan Board of Education who appoint one governor
  - (b) Parochial Church Council of the Parish, Ecclesiastical District or Team Ministry within which the school is for the time being situated who appoint five governors
7.
  - a) the holders of the following offices shall be a foundation governor ex officio: the principal officiating minister.
  - b) The foundation body or person named in paragraph 8 shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated, following consultation with the Diocesan Board of Education, shall have the power to request the

removal of the ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute.

9. The ethos statement of this voluntary school is:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

10. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1 September 2015.
11. This instrument was made by order of Trafford Local Authority on 31 July 2015
12. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
