



## **Impact of PP spending 2016/2017**

**2016/17 = £20,100**

### **Pupil premium objective 1 = £12 416**

£9310 % of TA3 salary used to support KS2 PP interventions, bug club etc.

£1890 for Third Space learning

£1216 is cost of First Quality teaching of phonics from teachers Mon pm, 10 mins daily catch up phonics with TA and Ta support

Evaluation

- Third Space learning had a significant impact on the attainment of pupil premium children: confidence in 1;1 communication, maths attainment including one child who is now at greater depth.
- Out of the 19 PP children 68% attained Age Related or above.

### **Pupil premium objective 2 = £2716**

£1500= Longford Park support package

Play therapy and focused TA pastoral support according to identified need.

£1216 = Senco paperwork time and TA support over the year for Emotional and behavioural support.

Evaluation

- Longford park play therapy has addressed some social and emotional needs enabling improved confidence and access to learning.
- Senco has been able to attend parent's evenings, and facilitated LAC meetings with all parents and supported teachers in implementing a graduated approach to learning.

### **Pupil premium objective 3 = £1090**

Music/drama lessons = £500

School trips = £200

Residential trips = £390

Evaluation

- Children have access to quality extra- curricular learning, the opportunity to learn an instrument, access to Karate clubs to help social and emotional development.
